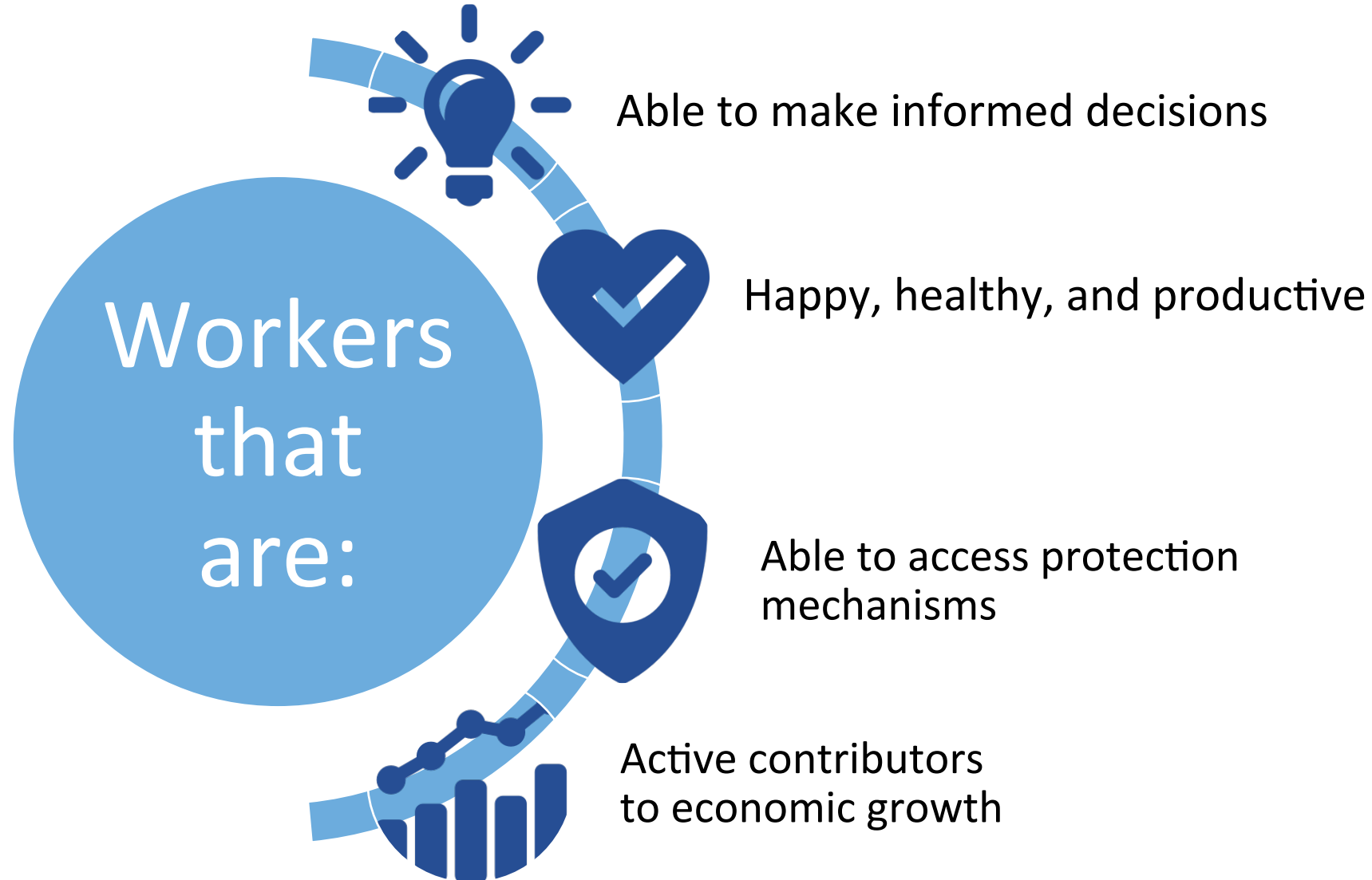

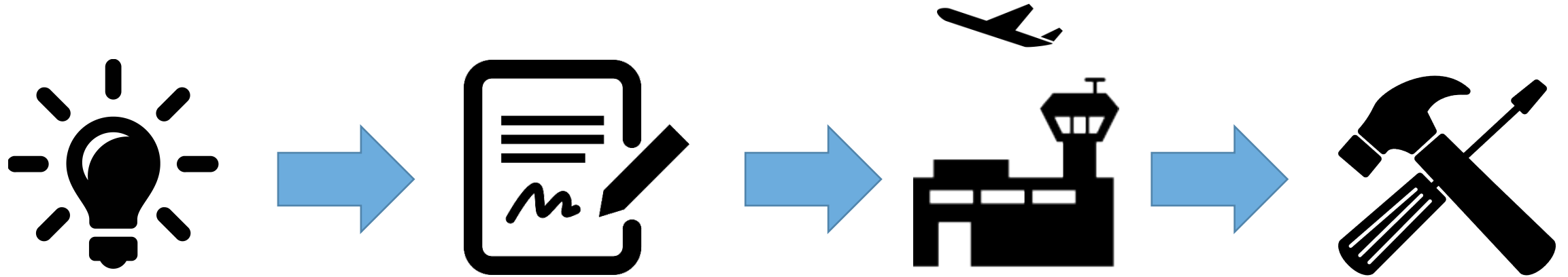

What has been achieved?

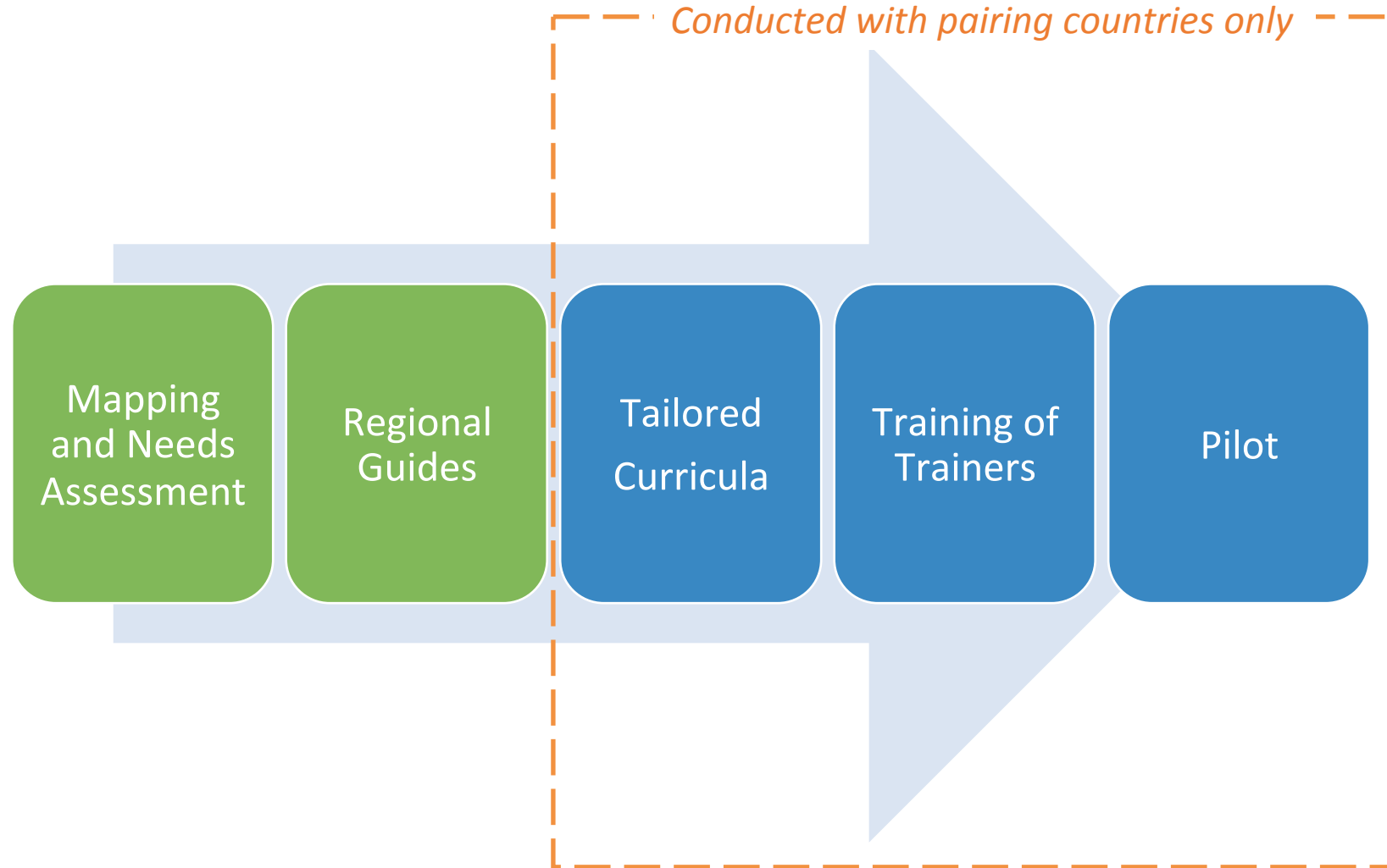
- At the 3rd Ministerial Consultation of the ADD in November 2014 a resolution was made on the initiative of the Philippines to implement CIOP.
- During the ADD SOM of the 4th Ministerial Consultation in January 2017 a dedicated workshop was held to discuss the outcomes of the first phase of CIOP and propose an overview for a Phase II.
- ADD Special Technical Workshop in July 2017 had specific breakout sessions for delegations of pairing to sit together and discuss the implementation of piloting of the full suite of CIOP materials once developed.

- ✓ Mapping of National PDO Programmes of Countries of Origin of the Abu Dhabi Dialogue
- ✓ Regional Guide for the PDO Modules and PDO Management Systems
- ✓ Region-specific framework for PAO modules developed by the ADD Permanent Secretariat.

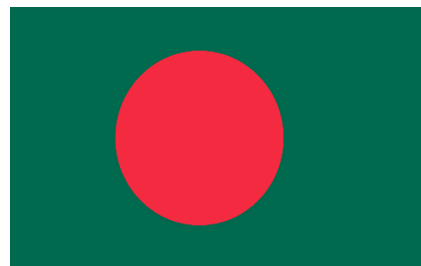

Countries of Destination

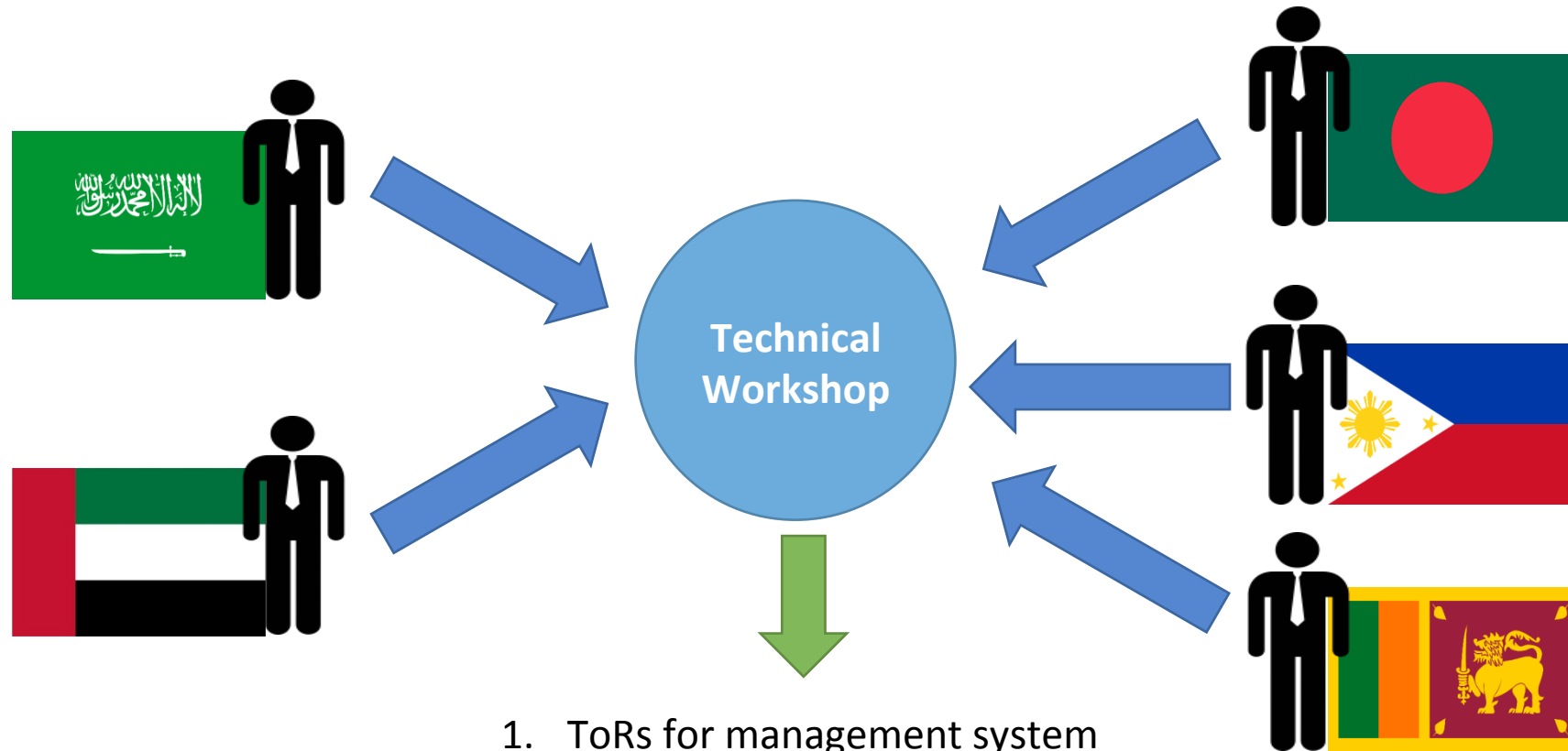


Countries of Origin



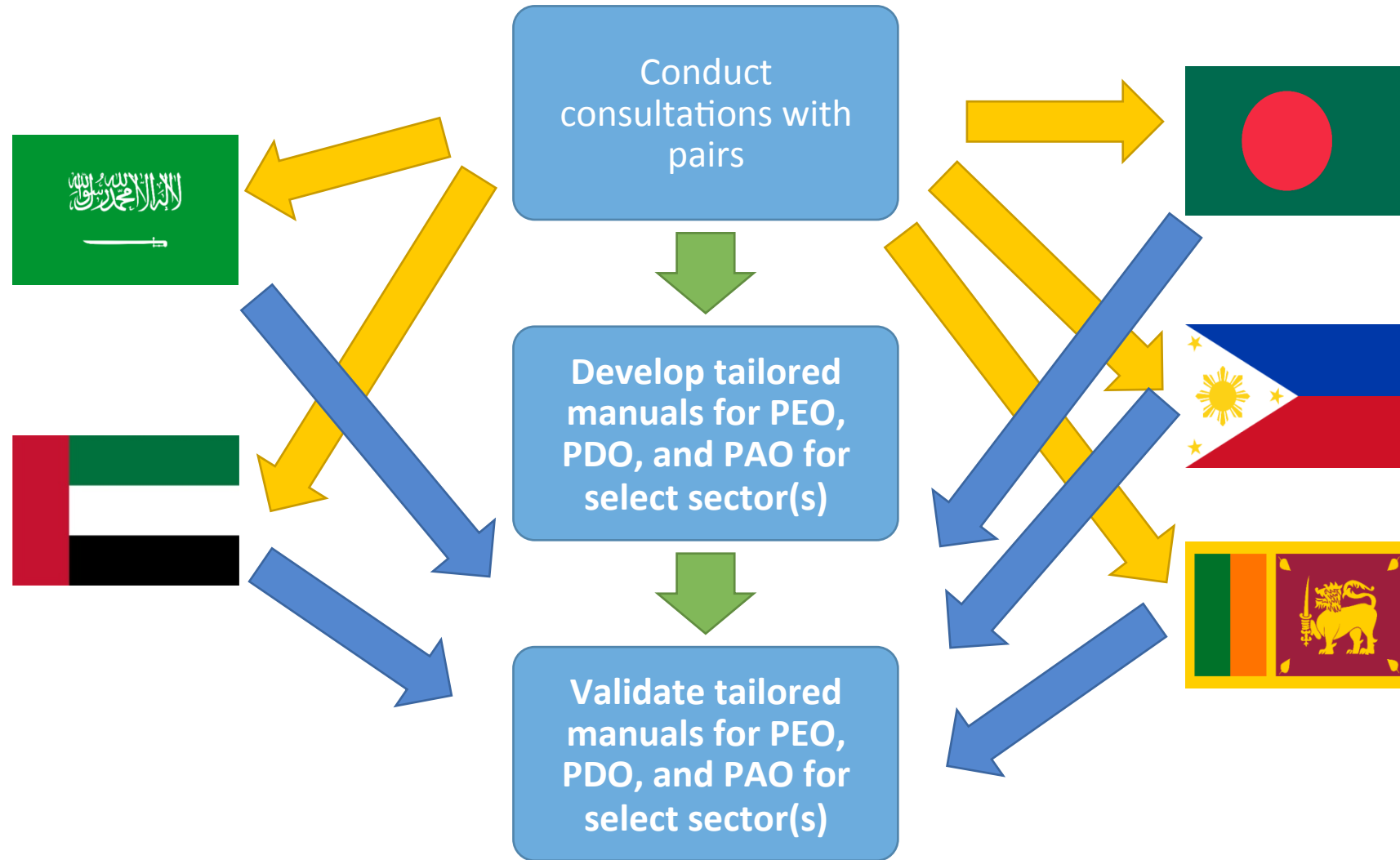

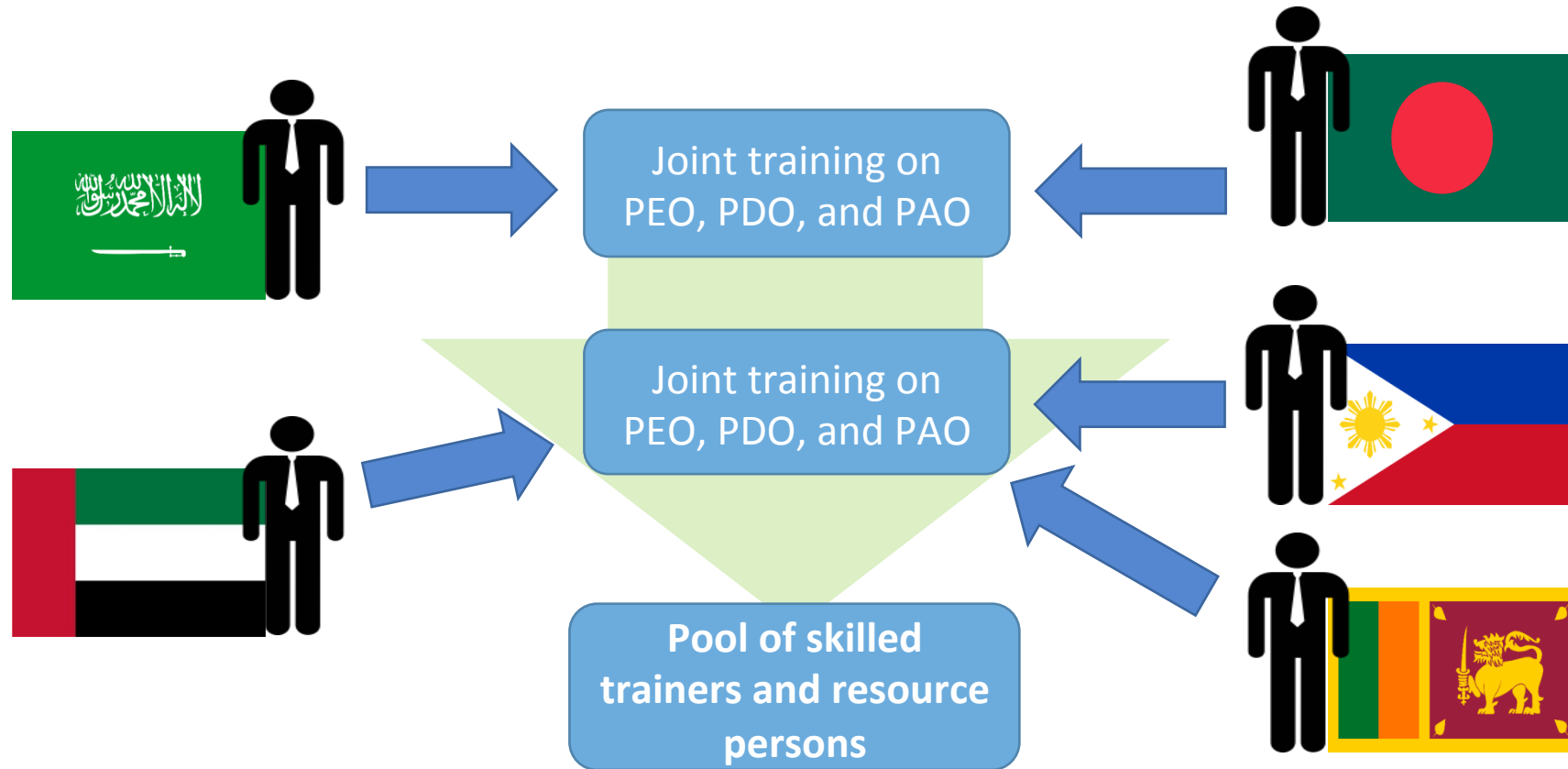

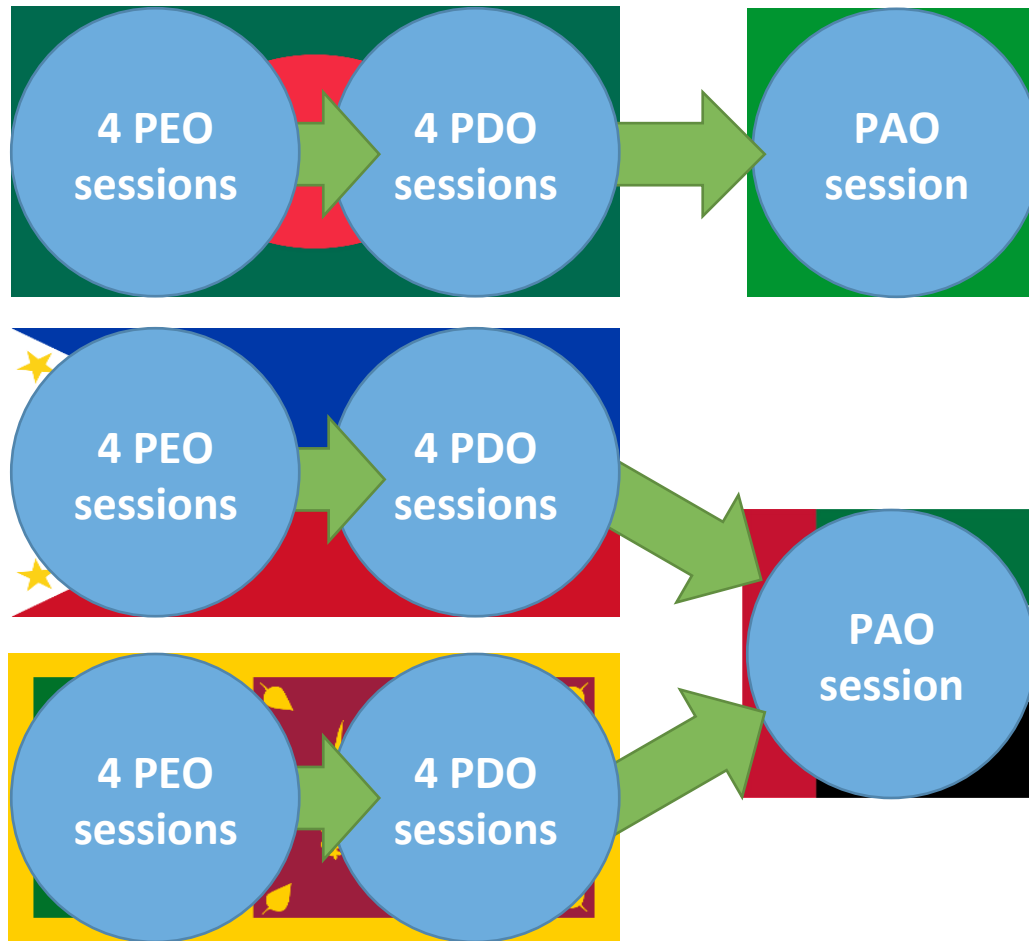
